CHA Increases Rent by Only 3%

Clydebank Housing Association is happy to report that they have been able to limit this year's increase to 3% across all of their housing stock. In real terms this works out at an estimated £6.50 per month rise for an average two bedroom property.

This represents good value for money for Clydebank Housing Association's tenants, particularly when tenants of other landlords in the area are facing proposed rent increases of between 3.8% and 5.8%. CHA has also achieved this without the need to cut any of the services they provide to their tenants, and they continue to offer a high standard of accommodation.

Joe Farrell, Senior Housing Officer said "Good budgeting and management of our running costs and arrears has enabled us to limit the required increase in rents to 3%. This also reaffirms our rents as being amongst the lowest and most affordable in West Dunbartonshire, which we feel is important to our tenants in the current difficult financial climate."
