We have secured £6k for Community Benefits from the builder Cruden. We have been working with Linnvale Community Group to decide how best to use this money. To date, the community group have confirmed the purchase of new waste bins and a balance of £3,800 is still available for community projects. Ideas received to date include the creation of a community garden and enhanced planting/ signage on the roundabouts entering the estate.
