We were delighted to have been successful in securing £341,398 of Investing in Communities Funding for 2023-2026 from the Scottish Government last year.

This funding will allow us to continue delivering our low-cost fitness classes, Strathclyde Autistic Society's Sports and Arts Clubs and ISARO Community Invitiative's classes, workshops, clubs and activities for Ethnic minorities.

We have also employed project staff which means we can deliver gardening workshops, a programme of led cyclerides, bike maintenance sessions, cookery classes and more!



Centre81, opened in 2008, is Clydebank Housing Association's community regeneration centre built in the heart of Whitecrook.

In the beginning...

Initially supported and funded with capital grants from the European ERDF Urban II Programme, The Big Lottery, Communities Scotland Wider Role Fund and West Dunbartonshire Council amongst others, this £2m+ Centre sprung into life!

Centre81 now funds some of its ongoing activities but still heavily relies on external funding to deliver projects and activities.

We continue to recognise the need to maximise access and opportunity for all and we bring the community together on a regular basis through fun family events! Our annual Gala Day is a great example of this but we also host Easter, October week and Christmas events.
