As at 31 March 2025, our housing stock totalled 1,213 units including over 30 Shared Ownership units. In terms of size, we are currently the largest community-controlled Housing Association in West Dunbartonshire and we employ 35 staff. We factor over 600 properties. We are run by a Management Committee made up of mainly local volunteers. We own and manage a thriving local community centre, Centre81, and

have a wholly-owned subsidiary, CHA Power Ltd, which provides low-cost heat and hot water to over 380 2-bedroom homes and a local church.
